

## For your safety, please follow these rules

- Be sure that your large PEDs should be carried in the passenger cabin with you whenever possible
- Any large PED that cannot be carried in the passenger cabin (e.g. due to its size) and therefore has to be carried in checked baggage, is:
  - Completely switched off and effectively protected from accidental activation. To ensure the device is never powered on during its transport, any application, alarm or pre-set configuration that may activate it shall be disabled or deactivated;
  - Protected from the risk of accidental damage by applying suitable packaging or casing or by being placed in a rigid bag protected by adequate cushioning (e.g. clothing)
  - Not carried in the same baggage together with flammable material (e.g. perfumes, aerosols, etc.)
- If any doubt, please advice to cockpit and cabin crew.



## PASSENGER BRIEFING ANNOUNCEMENTS – F-7X & F-8X

### **BEFORE TAKEOFF:**

Welcome aboard our **(Falcon 8X TC-RMK)** airplane. Please switch off any portable electronic devices, such as cellular phones, computers, CD players, etc. that can adversely affect the performance of the aircraft's systems and equipment, secure all loose items, fasten your seat belt, position your seat back fully upright, lock your seat in the full aft position, place the entertainment screens into its bay and open your window blinds.

To fasten your seatbelt, push the metal tab into the end of the metal buckle, then pull on the belt end to tighten. The belt may be released by lifting up on the top of the buckle.

There are two exits in the cabin, one on the left using as the main entrance door and **(choose as appropriate) A**: one on the right providing access to the right upper wing surface; **B**: one on the right providing access to the right floatation surface in an emergency.

Fire extinguisher and first aid kit are located in cabin behind the pilots' seats. Life jackets are located under your seat. In case there is a loss in cabin pressure, oxygen masks will deploy from the ceiling compartment located above you. Please make sure to secure your own mask before assisting others.

Smoking and using electronic devices are prohibited during the entire flight. You can also find safety briefing cards in seat packets. Please review its contents once again and ask if you have any question.

### **AFTER TAKEOFF:**

Smoking and using electronic devices are prohibited during the entire flight. Please keep your seat belts fastened when you are seated, even when the seat belt sign is OFF.

### **BEFORE LANDING:**

We are approaching our destination. Please check once again your portable electronic devices, such as cellular phones, computers, CD players, etc. are switched off, secure all loose items, fasten your seatbelt, position your seat back fully upright, lock your seat in the full aft position, place the entertainment screens into its bay and open your window blinds. In case of emergency evacuation please leave your hand baggages behind. After landing, do not unfasten your seatbelt until the seatbelt light is turned off and do not smoke until reaching the terminal area. Please review safety briefing cards located in seat packets.

### **AFTER LANDING:**

Please do not unfasten your seatbelt until the seatbelt light is turned off, do not use any portable electronic device and do not smoke until reaching the terminal area.
